## Cúinne na Gaeilge / Irish Language Corner

The parish around us is full of Irish. . These placenames were crudely translated to English in an attempt clean away any trace of a Gaelic Identity. Here are some:

Baile Bheannacht (Ballyvennaght)= The blessed townland.

Baile Riabhach (Ballyreagh) = The brindled or stripped townland.

Acra Bhile (Acraville, or Acravally)= Acre of the sacred tree (Usually an Ash Tree)

Bearnais (Barnish) = The Gap.

Gleann Maí Caorthainn (Glenmakeeran) = The Glen of field of Rowans ( Rowan is a tree).
