Carey travelled to St Mary's on 24<sup>th</sup> May, to find the home side in a mean mood, looking for survival points. Despite the stiff breeze, Carey were the far superior team in the first half, with points from Martin Mc Auley, Cathal Mc Auley and Julian Gillan, leaving us two ahead after the opening 15 minutes. Declan Mc Kay kept the home side in the game, with a couple of frees, but 2 Tommy Devlin points left us 0-5 to 0-3 ahead at the break.

The under-foot conditions and long grass certainly didn't suit good hurling, but a 40<sup>th</sup> minute Julian Gillan goal, left us 5 clear, only to be pegged back minutes later, when Mc Kay converted a 20m free for his sides only goal.

Carey finally got the act going with a couple of James Black points, followed by another from Colin Smyth. The home side picked up their final score with a point. Indeed, all their scores came from frees. Black again slotted over another point, before Martin Mc Auley sent over another couple of points, with Julian Gillan picking up the final score with a point.

Best for Carey were, Colm Mc Bride and Emmett Hunter in defence, with Tommy Devlin always working hard at midfield, and Smyth, Black and Gillan the pick of the forwards.

#### Carey 0-15 Sarsfields 2-6

This was our seventh straight, consecutive victory, and a very important one at that, on 27<sup>th</sup> May. The Shaw's Road outfit came here as the Division leaders. An early point for the visitors was cancelled out by six points in succession from Nat Hunter, Steven Mc Ginn, Colin Smyth, and 3 from Martin Mc Auley. However, a 24<sup>th</sup> minute goal from Sarsfields brought them back into the game. An Emmett Hunter point gave us a 0-7 to 1-3 lead at half-time.

Further points from Martin, Cathal, and Martin again stretched the lead to four, but a couple of frees kept the physical and sometimes over robust City side in contention.

With Colm Mc Bride playing a "stormer" at full-back, and Ciarán Mc Caughan and Emmett holding the Sarsfields half forwards out, it was no surprise when we entered the final ten minutes holding a 4 point lead again. With Emmett landing over two 80m points and another couple from Rory Mc Bride and Martin, Sarsfields scored a late goal. However, with time running out, Big Marty had the "final say", with an excellent point from play.
