Carey Faughs 1-10 Gort na Mona 0-13 (6th June)

Carey continued their recent good run of form with a strong and committed display away to Gort na Mona at the start of June. A strong start by the hosts saw them take an early 4 point lead. However a goal from a Martin McAuley 21-yard free settled Carey, and with the sides level at 1-04 to 7 points at half-time, Carey were looking the more likely to win. The second half saw Carey produce an excellent team display, leading 1-10 to 10 points with 8 minutes on the clock. However a controversial double sending off, Paul Devlin on the receiving end of a poor decision, saw the game turn on its head and 3 late points saw the game end in a creditable draw.

It took the Faughs some time to settle in the game and but for the excellent free taking of Martin Hunter in the opening half, the score line of 7 points to 1-06 could have been a lot worse. However half-time saw the Faughs re-group, and a surging burst from Colm McBride earned an early second half 21-yard free which was duly dispatched to the net by Martin McAuley. Carey's work rate and intensity could not be matched by Sarsfields who only managed to raise the white flag once in the second period.

Countess of Antrim Cup Semi Final

Carey Faughs 1-14 Cloughmills 0-14 (June 22nd)

With only 2 days to recover from their Championship exertions, Carey entered semi-final action in the Countess of Antrim, with a potentially tricky away tie to Cloughmills. The first half was a tight affair, but some excellent shooting from Carey, in particular Daniel McAllister, and a goal from the alert Shane McCambridge after a Martin McAuley penalty was saved, saw Carey take a 4 point lead to the break. Carey further stretched their lead early in the second period, and with the scoreboard reading 1-11 to 7 points with 15 minutes left, the game seemed over. However, the exertions of two days previous began to take their toll and Cloughmills rallied to within 3 points, despite some superb defensive work by Cathal McAuley, Michael McVeigh and Peter Murphy. With the result on an edge, the introduction of Kieran Kane, and Ciaran McCaughan gave the Faughs the energy they needed, and a superb long range point from Ciaran McCaughan sealed a well earned 3 point victory.

Countess of Antrim Cup Final (Winners for first time in over a decade!)

Carey Faughs 1-16 Armoy 3-7 (July 2nd)

This cup final had all the ingredients of a typical local derby, and had a nervous start as both teams conceded easy early goals. In the

opening half Armoy made the most of defensive errors to grab two goals while Carey, through Daniel McAllister, was fortunate to get on the end of a shot that rebounded off the Armoy goalie. Carey managed to control the mid field and with Martin Hunter getting 4pts, Martin McAuley, James Black, Shane McCambridge and Nat Hunter getting a point each, we went in with a 1-8 to 2-4 half time lead. In the second half while never fully gaining control, Carey never looked like losing this contest. Carey went 3 pts clear with points from Martin Hunter and a converted 65 from Martin McAuley. A defensive mix-up towards the end let Armoy in for their 3rd goal and a Lee Forsyth point gave Armoy a point lead. However, Carey pulled the lead back again to put the match into extra time. In extra time Carey's fitness levels showed and they were able to pull off a further 3 pts to bring the Countess of Antrim cup back to Carey for the first time since 1999.

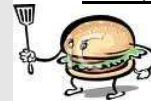
